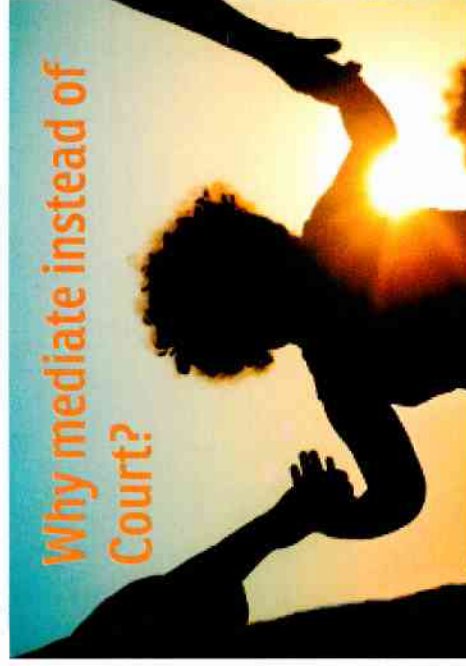

## What is Mediation?

- a meeting with a neutral, trained person and the other party to work out your parenting, support and/or property division after separation
- the process is creative - can happen with you both in the same room, or separate rooms
- helps both of you voice your concerns and assists you to make suggestions and examine options so you can decide what's best for your family



Over 90% of mediation clients are very pleased with the service, and over 85% of those cases resolve at least partially. Mediation puts control in your hands. If you have children and need to communicate in the future for their sake, mediation shows you how.

If you proceed with mediation there are user fees subsidized by the Ministry based on your income and number of dependents.
